### *Clinton Presidential Library*

Bill Clinton served as the 42nd President of the United States from 1993 until 2001. The American Presidency is part of a unique heritage that is yours to explore through archives, museums, and special programs. Presidential Libraries preserve the documents and artifacts of



our Presidents and provide insight into the times in which these Presidents lived and served the nation.

In addition to the archival collections and research facilities, the Clinton Presidential Library and Museum features exhibits, special events, and educational programs. The museum includes replicas of the Oval Office and the Cabinet Room. Permanent exhibits utilize documents, photographs, videos and interactive stations. A timeline and alcoves highlight domestic and foreign policy, as well as life in the White House.

The gala banquet will be Friday night at 7:00 pm. The dress code is "Sunday Best".
